# Social value in construction





At the Flitwick Transport Interchange project, we intend to generate £1.1m of social value for Central Bedfordshire Council. As of August 2022, we've delivered over £775,534 towards that goal.

Social value delivery is embedded in our values and business strategy. Where it becomes meaningful is when you look at an individual project and ask: how much social value was delivered and what did it look like to the people involved.
